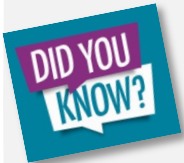

The origin of the name 'Audenshaw' is from the personal name 'Aldwyn' literally meaning 'Aldwyn's Copse' (a woodland clearing).

The earliest record of the name was in the 12th century.
